



Better Hearing Workshops

The Better Hearing Workshop (BHW) is led by the UNC Hearing and Communication Center. It is a 4-week series designed to provide information about hearing loss and hearing aid use, thereby increasing patient satisfaction with their hearing aids. These workshops address many frequently asked questions including:

- What does a hearing test reveal and what are the implications of hearing loss on communication?
- If one needs hearing aids, what options are there and which are the best?
- How can one better maintain hearing aids to extend their life?
- Why do people with expensive digital hearing aids still say “What?”
- What other ways can one improve hearing in difficult listening situations?

The BHW series is designed not only for those who have known hearing loss and wear hearing aids, but for those who are looking for more information about hearing loss/hearing aids and communication strategies. It is helpful for people to attend with their primary communication partner -as communication is a two-way effort.
